Description of content: The draft national technical regulation is based on ETSI EN 300 162-1 V1.4.1 (2006-05) and ETSI EN 300 162-2 V1.2.1 (2006-12) This national technical regulation specifies the minimum requirements for VHF receivers, transmitters for voice and digital select (DSC), with an external antenna connector for use on ships. This regulation applies to VHF radio receivers and transmitters operating in the maritime mobile service band (the specific frequency bands under the provisions of the national radio frequency spectrum planning) using both 12.5 kHz and 25 kHz channels.
